Dear CJSD Families,

I hope this correspondence finds you well and you are enjoying any monsoon rains you might have gotten lately in your neighborhood. I know you have been awaiting the specific details of our 2020 - '21 re-opening plan and it has been finalized and attached to this email. We thank everyone for their patience as we navigate the complex issues of these unprecedented times. Please review the communication plan thoroughly and let us know if you have any questions. We are here to provide clarity.

We know this is going to be the most unusual academic year in our lifetimes. You have an awesome faculty and staff that care deeply about our students. We have amazingly supportive families too. I am confident the CJSD family will rise up and persevere through this together.

Protocols within the communication plan for In Person learning were developed to keep student health and safety in the forefront. For example, we are busy working to get the building ready and you will see in our plan some of the steps we will take to clean and sanitize throughout the school day. Particular attention was given to transportation protocols along with food service, for example.

Upon recommendation from the Centers for Disease Control (CDC) and to comply with the Town of Clarkdale's face mask requirement, all members of our educational community will be required to wear a face covering while on campus (please see face covering section in communication plan) if physical distancing is not feasible. This includes students, parents, employees and families/visitors entering the front administration office. Folks will be required to check-in at the window at the administration office prior to entering. We want to ensure that we have proper physical distancing.

CVMS Online Learning Plan:

- Google Classroom weekly assessments (flexible times to complete). At least one summative assessment per week per core subject.
- Teachers/support staff will set up 1:1 and small group virtual meetings to support students as needed.
