Yavapai-Apache Nation Community Update

The Yavapai-Apache Nation's Coronavirus Stay-at-Home and Work-From-Home Directive will remain in place through the month of October to Friday October 30th, 2020. We will re-analyze the status of COVID-19 in our community at the end of October and determine next steps. All essential workers will remain working as they have been. All other employees who can work from home will continue to do so. Administrative leave will be applied in those cases where employees cannot carry out their work from home.

Curfew enforcement will remain in effect as well through the month of October. Please remember to abide by the procedures set by the security teams in the Middle Verde, Clarkdale and The Tunlii communities. Your participation and assistance in the curfew enforcement will continue to help keep our communities safe for all.

Please remember the COVID-19 Virus still poses a serious threat that affects all our communities and families. We cannot predict what the future will bring us since fall weather and the flu-season is now setting in, but with your help we can continue to be proactive in the steps taken to reduce any sickness that this terrible virus could bring to our communities.
