#### When Can I Get My COVID-19 Vaccine?

- It depends on your health status, age, and work. It also depends on the amount of vaccine received in accomplishing the first phase, already underway, for health care workers and nursing home residents getting vaccinated. The CDC has announced that states will receive an updated COVID-19 vaccine allocation beginning today.
- Arizonans 75 and older are now prioritized to be vaccinated against COVID-19 in the second phase (1B) of distribution following an updated recommendation by a panel of state, local, and tribal experts, including members of the Arizona Department of Health Services (ADHS). Phase 1B also includes frontline essential workers such as fire fighters, police officers, corrections officers, food and agricultural workers, United States Postal Service workers, manufacturing workers, grocery store workers, public transit workers, and teachers, support staff, and daycare workers. The Health Center is currently wrapping up a portion of the second phase 1B of essential worker vaccinations and will be starting the other half of phase 1B which includes patients 75 years and older.
- Phase 1C includes: People aged 65—74 years because they are at high risk of hospitalization, illness, and death from COVID-19; People aged 16—64 years with underlying medical conditions which increase the risk of serious, life-threatening complications from COVID-19; and other essential workers, such as people who work in transportation and logistics, food service, and finance, information technology, communications.
